On August 8, 2007, the Board of Directors of Applera Corporation (Applera) announced two initiatives. The Board said it has retained Morgan Stanley to explore alternatives to Applera s current tracking stock structure, including the possibility of creating two independent publicly traded companies in place of the two tracking stocks. Also, the Board said it has increased to \$1.2 billion the current authorization to repurchase shares of Applera Corporation-Applied Biosystems Group Common Stock.
