On September 3, 2002, General Dynamics ( the company ) issued a press release announcing that on August 30, 2002, the Department of the Navy notified the company and the Boeing Company that unless they paid, within 30 days, approximately $\$ 2.3$ billion that the government says the companies owe in the A-12 aircraft case, it would turn the matter over to the Defense Finance and Accounting Service for collection. The letter acknowledged that negotiations regarding a settlement of the A-12 matter are ongoing.
