Payment of premium on CVRD s Shareholder Debentures

Rio de Janeiro, March 22, 2005 Companhia Vale do Rio Doce (CVRD) informs that it will pay a premium on its shareholder debentures of R\$ 0.019005992 per debenture, amounting to a total of R\$ 7,384,950.36. Income tax is levied on this payment and will be retained at source at a rate of 20%, with the exception of those institutional investors who have proved exemption from income tax.

The funds will be available as of April 1, 2005 at CETIP (Center for the Custody and Financial Settlement of Securities) for those investors holding debentures registered on the SND (National Debenture System), and at Banco Bradesco S.A. for those whose debentures are not linked to the SND.
